

KCTA – Frequently Asked Tornado Related Questions:

- Were the historical artifacts recovered?
 - Many of the items in the clubhouse are in safe storage, however, as the building was in dangerous condition club officials were not allowed access to everything.
- Are the trap and skeet machines functional?
 - As of now it is believed that the machines are functional, however we do not have access at this time to test them.
- Were the trap/skeet houses damaged?
 - The roof of Low 2 is missing I believe, the fence between Skeet 2 and Trap 1 is blown over. The damage was not assessed completely as of this writing.
- Will the clubhouse be rebuilt?
 - It is our intention at this time to build back better than ever!
- Will there be a “cleanup day”?
 - As soon as the County Administration gives us permission we will assess the damage and see what we can do begin the cleanup process.
